WHEREAS the base limitation established under section 77-3446 is two and one-half percent; and WHEREAS a governmental unit may exceed the limit provided for a fiscal year, by up to an additional one percent, based on the affirmative vote of at least seventy-five percent to the governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Boyd County Board of Supervisors, by a majority affirmative vote exceeding 75 percent, resolved to approve an additional one percent increase to the based amount for restricted fund authority; for a total increase of three and one-half percent in the restricted funds authority for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.

# RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08-23-4

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of Boyd County passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governing Body of Boyd County, resolves that:

- 1. The 2023-2024 property tax request be set: General Fund \$ 2,000,000.00.
- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 1 percent.
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be **0.322843** per \$100 of assessed value.
- 4. Boyd County proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be **0.328845** per \$100 of assessed value.
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of **Boyd County** will increase or decrease last year's budget by **19 percent**.
- 6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2023.
