WHEREAS, in the above agreement the County has pledged sufficient funds to finance its share of the cost of the construction of this project identified as BRO-7008(13), and

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned agreement providing that the County will pay costs as set forth in the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the State, on behalf of the County received bids for the construction of this project based on the final plans and specifications on October 03, 2019, at which time 5 bids(s) were received for the construction of the proposed work, and

WHEREAS, the following Contractor(s) for the items of work listed has/have been selected as the low bidder(s) to whom the contract(s) should be awarded:

HERBST CONSTRUCTION, INC., LE MARS, IA 51031-0728

GRADING, SEEDING, BRIDGE AT SATION15+40.00, GUARDRAIL, GENERAL: \$1,063,674.75





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NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above facts, the county, by this resolution, takes the following official actions:

- If for any reason the Federal Highway Administration rescinds, limits its obligations, or defers payment of the Federal share of the costs of this project, the County hereby agrees to provide the necessary funds to pay for all costs incurred until and in the event such Federal funds are allowed and paid.
- 2. The Board hereby concurs in the selection of the above-mentioned Contractor(s) for the items of work listed, to whom the contract(s) should be awarded.
- 3. The Board hereby approves of the final plans and specifications that were used in the bidding process for this project.
- 4. The Board hereby authorizes the Board Chairperson to sign the contract(s) with the above-mentioned Contractor(s) for the above-mentioned work on behalf of the County.

SIGNING OF THE YEAR-END CERTIFICATION OF COUNTY HGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT FORM 2019 Whereas: State of Nebraska Statutes, sections 39-2302, and 39-2501 through 39-2505 details the requirements that must be met in order for a county to qualify for an annual Incentive Payment.

Whereas: The State of Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) requires that each county must annually certify (by December 31st of each year) the appointment of the County Highway Superintendent to the NDOT using the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form;

Whereas: The NDOT also requires that such certification shall also include a copy of the meeting minutes showing the appointment of the County Highway Superintendent by their name as it appears on their License (if applicable), their License number and Class of License (if applicable), the type of appointment, i.e., employed or under contract (consultant, or interlocal agreement with another county and/or incorporated municipality), and the beginning date of the appointment; and

Whereas: The NDOT also requires that such Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form shall be signed by the County Board Chairperson and shall include a copy of a resolution of the County Board authorizing he signing of the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form by the County Board Chairperson.

Be it resolved that the County Board Chairperson of Boyd County is hereby authorized to sign the attached Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent form.
